- Initiate, coordinate, direct and evaluate plans, schedules and site personnel to ensure appropriate and effective allocation of resources
- Identify and implement training and development needs for foremen and general foremen.
- Conduct performance evaluations on foremen and general foremen as required.
- Oversee, direct, coordinate and delegate tasks and responsibilities to work crew.
- Provide leadership and direction to general foremen, foremen and labourers in the areas of safety, machine operation, and quality.
- Ensure quality standards are met and exceeded.
- Conduct root-cause analysis for barriers slowing down project progress or issues related to quality.
